

Kindergarten Readiness Class

Purpose:

- To let incoming students and families acclimate to NCA and specifically the kindergarten program
- To introduce students to kindergarten routines and procedures to help them set up for success
- To begin building relationships with teachers and families
- To begin to build a parent community as they transition into the academy

Highlights:

Beginning kindergarten is a huge milestone in children's lives! It can be a time when children feel anxious about what school is all about. In this class, children will have the opportunity to experience a kindergarten classroom setting with classroom routines and procedures. They will have fun while learning the independent skills that are needed for kindergarten. Children learn reading readiness skills and participate in phonemic awareness activities that prepare them for beginning phonics. There will be practice with counting and number sense, as well as fine motor activities.

Sample Schedule

8:50: Meet in Lobby. Stay until 9:00

9:00 – 9:30: Prayer, calendar, weather, Big Book- I Love School

Reflection Question: What are you excited about school? What do you love about school? Talk about what the students are most excited about or what they love about school.

9:30-9:55: Centers- Legos, connectors, letter road, phonemic awareness, number sense puzzles and have two rotations.

9:55-10:10: Recess

10:10-10:20: Bathroom

10:20 – 10:50: Art- Pencil craft

10:50: Circle Time- End the time. Let them know how excited we are to have them in kindergarten this year. Pray. Be up at the Lobby by 11:00.
